Internships, extraordinary experiences, seasonal jobs, volunteering, work abroad. Includes 3 introductory sections to help assess what experiences you are looking for, begin the decision-making process, find funding, and reviews of books resources and web links that help "supercharge, guide, inspire and shape your life." Includes a unique index by program length in months.

#### **Gardner's Guide to Internships in New Media**

This book is designed to equip students with the knowledge to find internships in the field of new media, computer graphics, animation, web page design, television production, graphic design and many other areas. Includes great resume examples - both standard and online.
